BEFORE YOU START

Remove all parts from packaging and check against the parts list.

Do not discard any packaging until you are sure you have all parts and the pack of fittings.

You will find it easier to assemble the cot if a second adult is available to help you.

Read the instructions thoroughly before attempting to construct the cot bed.

SAFETY INSTRUCTION

One end of the cot has a mark indicating the height of the mattress. The thickness of the mattress must not reduce the internal depth from mattress surface to top of the cot side above it to less than 500 mm in the lowest position and 200 mm in the highest position of the mattress base. The lowest mattress base positions is the safest and should always be used as soon as the baby is old enough to sit up. The recommended mattress size for the cot is 120 x 60 cm

If you leave the child unattended in the cot, always make sure that the dropside is in the highest position.

Do not use the cot on an uneven surface.

Be aware of the risk of open fires and other sources of strong heat, such as electric bar fires, gasfires, etc... in the near vicinity of the cot.

Keep children at a safe distance when assembling or disassembling the cot.

All fittings should always be tightened properly and that care should be taken that no screws are loose, because a child could trap parts of the body, or clothing (e.g. strings, necklaces, ribbons for babies dummies, etc), which would pose a risk of strangulation.

Keep all hazards (knives, hot drinks, electrical flexes etc.) out of reach of your baby. Do not leave anything in the cot which could provide a foothold or present a danger of suffocation or strangulation. Do not place cot near windows where cords from blinds or drapes may strangle a child.

MAINTENANCE

Check regularly to ensure that all the components are secure. Do not use if any parts are broken or missing. Only parts supplied by TROLL Nursery should be used.

Store in a dry ventilated place when not in use.


The correct use and maintenance of your cot bed will ensure it gives long and trouble free use. When somebody else is using your cot bed, ensure they also know how to use it.

Your cot can be cleaned by wiping with a damp cloth and drying with a soft clean cloth. Do not use abrasives, bleach, alcohol or ammonia based household polishes.


Take care when handling or moving the cot. Careless handling can damage wooden furniture..

The safety of your child is your responsibility.







Insert Allen-head bolt **A** through the holes on the cot inside sides and screw them in headboards mounting holes.

Tighten loosely. Tighten securely only after you have completed the procedure shown on diagram 3.

Securely tighten all Allen-head bolts **A** after mattress base is placed into required position.
